2018 Road Pavement Repair

- All work is complete

Gravity Belt Thickener Building Project

- Bids received May 10th project well over budget.
- PCE developed alternate work scope and negotiated construction contracts
- Review current bids and project budget

24 Mile Sanitary Pump Station

- Repairs made to station structure joints.
- Monitoring of station indicates station has settled 6" since November 16, 2017, stress is also evident from recent force main internal repairs and TV inspection of lines. Underground electric is likely under the same stress. Repair options being considered to stabilize the station and utilities.

SAW Grant Activity

- Flow meters have been obtained and installation scheduled
- City departments and PCE are currently marking existing utilities for GPS locating.
- Sanitary sewer TV inspection started. Smaller 8" lines need more extensive cleaning for access. Considering alternate equipment and methods, quotes being obtained for demonstration.
- Three point repairs made to sewer lines, to demonstrate internal patching capabilities.

Other Updates:

- Water Plant Roof Replacement- Pending quote for complete Duro-Last System
- Murdick & Walpole Water Main Replacement- Murray Underground-work just started
- Treatment Plant Process Modification Project- model has been created, and has been a useful tool for process changes
- Crackfill program- plans in progress
- Street mapping and condition assessment- initial map created
- Taylor Street Replacement- special assessment under consideration, petition created
- Sanitary sewer/treatment considerations for Brewery operations, possible ordinance revisions.
- Water rates- ordinance language, cost of living increase, capital charges, tap fees, contractors to do taps (instead of DPS)
