


RECYCLING SCHEDULE



*This map applies to recycling collection only and does NOT change your trash or yard waste pickup days.

DETERMINING YOUR RECYCLE WEEK & DAY

SEE SCHEDULE

Use the map and schedule for each year to determine your recycle week as follows:

First determine if your residence is located in the green or yellow section of the map. The color of the map where your residence is located corresponds to the color of each Wednesday on the annual schedule and indicates your recycle week and day for each month and year. Place your recycle cart at the curb on the Wednesday designated on the schedule.

Waste Management will provide you with a new recycle schedule for dates beyond 2018.

PLACE YOUR RECYCLE CART AT THE CURB ON THE SAME DAY AS YOUR TRASH EVERY OTHER WEEK.

CURB CARTS

96 Gallon curb carts for trash only, are available for purchase (\$75.00/container) or rental (\$4.00/container/month) and a one time delivery charge of \$15.00.

Call 866-797-9018 to arrange for purchase/rental and delivery.

SPECIAL PICKUP

Once per year the City of New Baltimore schedules a city wide clean up. Call the DPW Offices for the date at 586-725-9511

HOLIDAY SCHED.

WM observes the following holidays, therefore no collection service on the following: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day (July 4th), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

If a holiday is on a Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday, then your service will be one day behind on that following Thursday. Service WILL NOT be delayed when the holiday falls on a weekend.

PLEASE READ! IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT NEW BALTIMORE SOLID WASTE & RECYCLE PROGRAM



WASTE MANAGEMENT is the solid waste, recycling and yard waste service provider for the City of New Baltimore. Our collection crews look forward to providing you with the best service in the industry today.

COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Your pick ups will occur each week on Wednesday. To ensure pick up, please have your items at the curb by 6:00 AM or the night before your Wednesday collection day.

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION

WM will collect at the curbside solid waste placed in 96 gallon carts (see section on 96 Gallon WM Approved Curb Carts), 32 gallon containers and plastic bags tied and secured. This includes discarded household waste, food waste, rubbish and refuse generated by residential dwelling. Do not place rubbish in paper bags.

Place bags of rubbish in 96 gallon curb cart or cans no larger than 32-gallons, with lids or tied plastic bags at the curb for collection. No container or bag should weigh more than 50 lbs. each.

BULK ITEMS

Large items such as furniture, appliances (including refrigeration units WITHOUT Freon), stove, hot water tank, grills, etc. will be collected on the same day with your rubbish. Please remove doors from refrigerators before placing at the curb (for the safety of children playing nearby). Carpet is accepted. It must be rolled and tied in 4 foot sections and weigh no more than 50 lbs. No more than 10 bundles at any one time. Place at curb with your rubbish by 6:00 AM or the night before.

BULK WASTE COLLECTION

Bulk items will be collected the same day as regular household waste. NO call ahead needed. Storm doors and windows must have glass removed and packaged separately in a box, taped closed and marked "BROKEN GLASS", weighing no more than 50 lbs.

Building material, remodeling projects and home repairs shall not exceed one bushel in volume or weigh more than 50 lbs.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

YARD WASTE IS:

Grass clippings, leaves, shrubs & brush trimmings (under 2 inches in diameter and less than 4 feet in length)

YARD WASTE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

Sod, pet waste, dirt, rocks, trash, root balls, branches (over 2 inches in diameter and longer than 4 feet in length)

Yard Waste Collection is from the first Wednesday in April to the last Wednesday in November.

PLACE YARD WASTE AT THE CURB FOUR (4) FEET FROM YOUR RUBBISH IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

- Place yard waste in brown paper bags or 32 gallons cans CLEARLY MARKED "YARD WASTE" (stickers available at City Hall). Face Yard Waste Markings Toward the Street, so the driver can identify the can as yard waste. **DO NOT USE A PLASTIC BAG LINER.** For the safety of our employees, containers over 32 gallons will not be collected due to weight. No container should weigh more than 50 lbs.
- Place yard waste in designated paper yard waste bags available at local retail stores. **DO NOT USE PAPER GROCERY BAGS OR BOXES.** No sticker is required.
- Bundle brush and branches that are 2 inches in diameter or less in 3-4 foot long bundles with string. Please insure bundles are no larger than 18 inches around and weigh no more than 50 lbs each. Yard waste mixed with rubbish cannot be collected.

ITEMS WE DO NOT COLLECT

- Gasoline & Automotive Oil
- Car & Truck Parts / Engines / Tires
- Hazardous Waste
- Yard Waste Mixed with Trash
- Concrete / Bricks
- Cyclone Fencing / Railroad Ties
- Tree Stumps
